

CHAMPION 3400 DUAL-FUEL MODIFIED TO RUN OFF OF RV'S ON BOARD GAS LINE

Forest River Forum member ClutchD tested and provided these photos. From his June 2016 message with a few additional edits:

Ran the generator off propane for 2 hours for a good test. Went right off the low pressure quick connect. Turned the ac on and the Champion then went off economy for a few seconds then right back to economy. Ran great for an hour. Decided to test the generator limits. Turned the battery charger on and experienced a little surge of the gen. Then turned the fridge on electric and it came off economy and stayed there. If not running the microwave or the water heater on electric it will run great. Logically, it makes no sense to waste a lot of propane just so the gen can run the fridge and water heater on electric when it is more efficient in a non-shore power situation to have them both set to using their internal propane option. But this was just to test the gen.

The Champion Dual Fuel is to be used mainly for A/C this weekend as I'll be in the middle of a field with no shade. It should be noted that the Dual Fuel is rated 3400 on Gasoline and only 2800 on Propane. This is because Propane is a less efficient fuel source than Gasoline.
