Volunteer Opportunities

Putting on a Rally requires a lot of work and a lot of help. We are looking for volunteers to help with various functions at the event. There are always plenty of things to be done, but here are some of the major functions that we can identify. If you would like to volunteer for any of these, please mark those for which you can help and send in this form either with your registration or by July 1.

We will contact members of the Parking Committee and the Registration / Welcome Bag Committee in order to confirm and coordinate early arrivals.

Note that there are ALWAYS opportunities to help, so please feel free to offer at the rally as well! Parking Committee This group assists rally attendees with locating and getting into their assigned parking spaces. Members of the committee greet guests at the gate and lead them by golf cart to their spaces. We ask that members of the committee arrive on Friday in order to become acquainted with the layout of the fairground, the location of the various parking sections, and the parking procedures. (FROG will pay for your camping on Friday and Saturday.) While most attendees will be arriving on Sunday, volunteers will need to be available on part of Saturday and Monday as well. Registration / Welcome Bag Committee This group will greet attendees at the registration office after they have arrived and parked. Members of this group will register members as they arrive, provide welcome bags and other registration material, and answer questions. They will also be responsible for filling welcome bags with information and welcome gifts before hand. We ask that committee members arrive on Friday to fill bags and to become acquainted with procedures and with the layout of the fairground. (FROG will pay for your camping on Friday and Saturday.) While most attendees will be arriving on Sunday, volunteers will need to be available on part of Saturday and Monday as well. Shuttle Drivers Shuttle drivers will drive "limo"-type golf carts to help transport attendees to and from meals, as well as around the fairground during the day. Shuttle drivers must be at least 18 and have a valid driver's license. **Bus Group Leaders** For each of the bus trips (both the optional trips and the factory tours) we need someone to hold a sign to identify the bus at the fairground to ensure that people get on the correct bus. This person will also count the people on the bus and ensure that everyone is on board before leaving each stop on the trip. Attendance Prizes During the week we will have drawings for attendance prizes. Rally attendees will stop by the vendor building each morning to see if they have won a prize. We need volunteers to staff the prize booth and distribute prizes to winners.
