Another feature not found on any travel trailer other than the Aviator is 50 Amp service. The Aviator has 50 Amp service meaning all electronics and appliances can be powered without worrying about blowing a fuse. The Aviator's heavy duty power cord is 50 ft. long. The exterior power outlet (located on rear off-door-side wall) is equipped with a blue LED light (visible on top of cover) to signal if your travel trailer is receiving power or not.



The Wright Flyer features a hydraulic-lift table. This large table top is the same solid surface countertop that's used in the Aviator's kitchen. This table is easily moved up or down and locks into position, so you don't have to worry about the table rising during transport or collapsing down when you're enjoying a meal. And because this table locks into place, you don't need to hassle with straps to hold the table down.

This table has plenty of clearance between the seat cushions to get in and out of the massive U-shaped dinette and provides superior comfort.

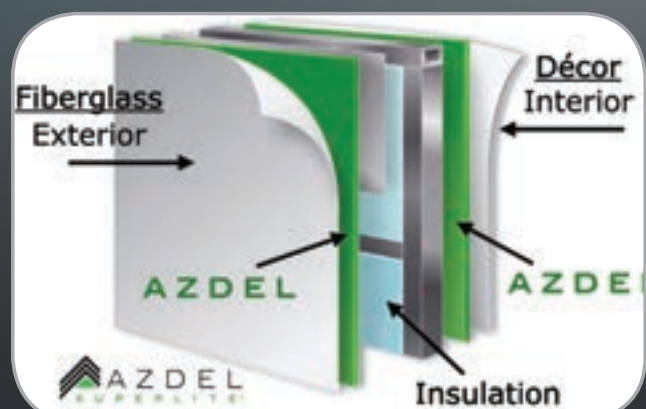


The Aviator uses solid surface countertops in the kitchen, bathroom and dinette table. These countertops are easy to clean and are resistant to most household chemicals. It's a safe surface that is laboratory tested to meet strict modern environmental standards.



This is the enclosed termination system. This provides easy access to your black tank flush, grey water tank valve, black tank valve, hot water heater bypass, winterization valve, anti-freeze input and your outside shower with a 15 ft. long hose (sprayer hose not shown). The Aviator's outside shower sprays filtered hot and cold water. This is all secured by a lockable door.

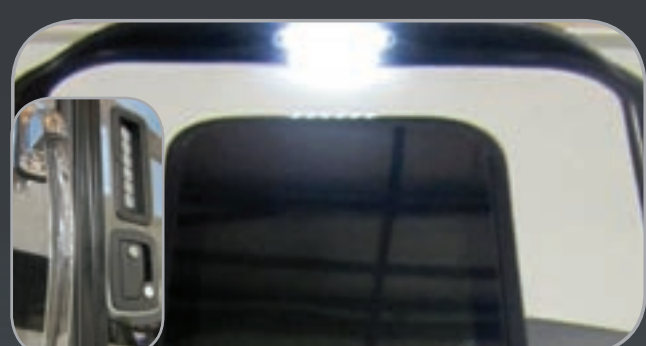
Now you don't have to worry about getting on the ground and reaching under your RV to dump your tanks.



Azdel is a composite synthetic material used to replace luan. Luan is a thin wood board utilized in almost all RV walls. In the Aviator, there is no wood in the floor, roof or sidewalls. This has made our structure impervious to water damage meaning your walls, roof or floor won't rot, crack or form mold and mildew. Azdel is not only more durable than wood, it's 50% lighter, provides insulation and sound absorption. Azdel is odorless and contains no volatile organic compounds (VOCs).



This is a picture of the Aviator's "mood lighting." Our mood lights are backlit-blue LEDs which are operated by a dimmer control switch. Set the mood in the living room or the bedroom (both control by separate dimmer switch).



Optional Keyless Entry Door with Motion Sensor Light. In addition to traditional keys, you will have a key fob (just like a car) and a keypad (as seen in the photo). Now, keep your keys inside your RV and eliminate the risk of losing them. The LED Motion sensor light (seen on right) is located at the top of the doorframe. All Aviator doors also include large sturdy grab handles to assist campers getting into or out of the Aviator. The Aviator keyless entry system is connected to the battery and does not have its own power source. Many RV keyless entry doors do not wire the system to the batteries and instead use its own small internal battery. The Aviator has eliminated the maintenance of an internal battery as well as the risk of losing power and being unable to open your door.



The Aviator is the first RV to introduce this type of modern technology. The Aviator has an option called M.O.S.T. (Mobile Onboard Smart Technology). This includes a Sony® Tablet and a Linksys® wireless router. You can wirelessly stream music, video or pictures onto your entertainment centers. Check email, RV campsite directories, research tourist attractions, check the weather, where to dump your tanks, watch Netflix, check campsite availability or Skype™ with your family.

The Sony® tablet can control: fireplace, all televisions, outside entertainment center, Blu-Ray player. The Sony® tablet also includes the owner's manual, warranty information and appliance user guides.



The Carefree Freedom Freestyle awning is the premier awning of the industry. This is a free-standing awning meaning there are no support legs. The awning is operated by a scissor-arm mechanism and retracts or extends very quickly. This awning was built to last because of two features: wind sensor and the aluminum box. When retracted, this awning is covered and protected in an aluminum box. This eliminates the threat of an awning banging against the wall while driving or having your awning randomly open. The wind sensor will automatically retract the Aviator's awning during strong gusts of wind. If you are away from your campsite or asleep in bed, you don't have to worry about a storm destroying your awning.

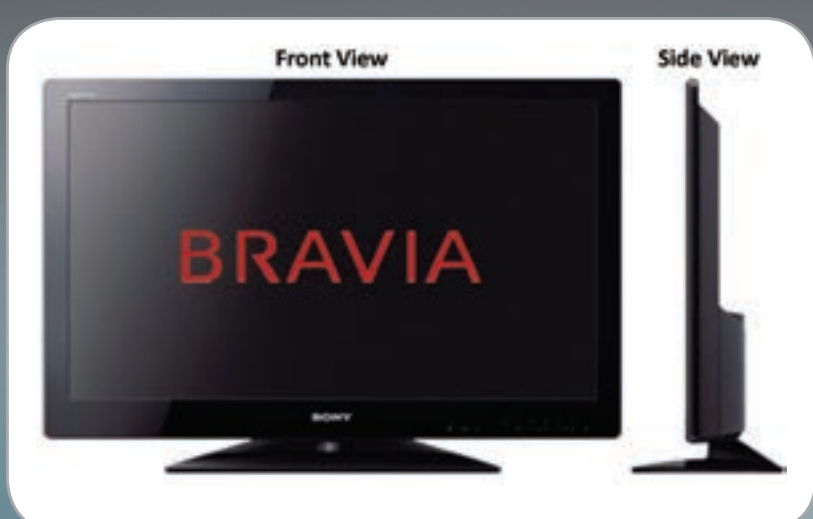


This is another feature exclusive to the Aviator in the travel trailer industry. Aviator uses a one-piece fiberglass roof (just like a high-end motor home). This is a solid barreled roof that is about 5 1/2 inches thick and can be walked on. The Aviator roof is a low-maintenance roof and fully painted with several clear coat applications.

The Aviator's awning is also unique. It's a roof mounted box-style awning. Unlike a traditional awning, there are no support legs and it's equipped with a wind sensor. Strong gusts of wind will automatically retract your awning, so you don't have to worry about your awning being torn apart by a wind storm.



The Aviator's cabinets are completely impervious to water damage. Why? Because the cabinets are not made of wood. The radius European influenced cabinets are constructed of aluminum, closed-cell PVC and a synthetic organic polymer laminate. The Aviator uses the same cabinets that are in state-of-the-art laboratories because of the resistance to harsh chemicals, extreme temperatures and water. All cabinet drawers use fully extendable ball bearing drawer guides and all cabinet doors have hidden residential hinges. Overhead cabinet doors also have gas struts to hold the doors open, so you don't have to.



The Aviator uses powerful MaxxAir Fans. The bathroom MaxxAir Fan is a five speed exhaust fan, while the bathroom and living room utilizes a ten speed intake/exhaust fan. Since the Aviator's ceilings are almost 6'10" tall, we know it can be difficult to reach to control your fans. That is why our fans are controlled by a wall mount control panel which includes an automatic climate control feature. Enjoy staying cool with our MaxxAir fans whether rain or shine because Aviator MaxxAir fans include a rain shield to protect your RV.



Aviator's aerodynamic one piece fiberglass cap is equipped with a hydraulic lifting hood, just like a motor home. The hood protects the trailer's batteries and LP tanks while locked in place with powerful compression locks, and is easily accessible. Two 90 # LP bottles and two batteries provide a lot of power to a very efficient travel trailer. The front cap is also covered with a layer of Diamond Shield.



One of the many great features of the Aviator is its storage capacity, especially the pull-out pantry. Whether it's clothes or cookware, the Aviator has an abundance of stowing ability.

This pantry has eight adjustable wire baskets. You can accommodate for the smallest salt shaker or the largest cereal box.

Most importantly, this sturdy slide mechanism also includes a base lock so your pantry doesn't open during transport. It's a small feature which provides a lot of protection to the inside of your trailer.



All Aviators come with a 16GB SD card which has electronic copies of the owner's manuals, warranty information, appliance manuals, electrical specifications and a list of all products used in the Aviator. Now instead of having a stack of papers (which can get lost or destroyed) and searching through the index or table of contents, you'll have electronic copies so you can easily search what you're looking for. The SD card is a much easier process for you to better understand your Aviator.



This is a great simple feature that not many RVs have. Aviator's LED courtesy lights are located along the base of the galley and on both sides of the bed, in every model. These lights are controlled by a light switch at the bedroom nightstand or on the control panel. If you need to see where you are walking in your Aviator, but don't want to turn on all the lights and wake up anyone, the courtesy lights fill your need for great night lighting.



The Aviator has plenty of storage. This is a picture of the Aviator's rear pass thru storage. It has a capacity of 30 cubic feet (about 76 cu. ft. outside storage total on Wright Flyer) and it's fully enclosed (no exposed wires or pipes). It's also lit with LED lights so you can access your storage at night. Don't worry about your belongings either because they are safe with two water-tight sealed lockable slam latch doors.



The Aviator has the thickest walls in the industry. The thick wall is one of the many features which has established the Aviator as a four-season travel trailer. Aviator's sidewall R value is more than double of most the industry. Our wall construction has also set us apart from other RVs in the industry. Aviator walls contain no wood, making it impervious to water damage. With an all aluminum and composite construction, the Aviator has eliminated the biggest threat to a RV.



Aviator's Sony® Blu-ray Home Theater System blows the competition away. You can enjoy full HD Blu-ray or DVD movies while listening to a premium 1,000-watt 5.1-channel surround sound audio system. The built-in Wi-Fi® lets you stream entertainment such as Netflix®, YouTube®, Hulu®, Pandora® and much more. The Sony® surround system also includes an iPod/iPhone/Android docking station. Now you can charge your Apple® device while streaming to music or watching a movie. You can also play DVDs, watch satellite/cable, or listen to FM radio, CDs, or MP3s.

The outside Sony® multi-disc player is controlled by a remote control but is also fully controlled by the optional Sony® tablet.
